Benefits of the Position:

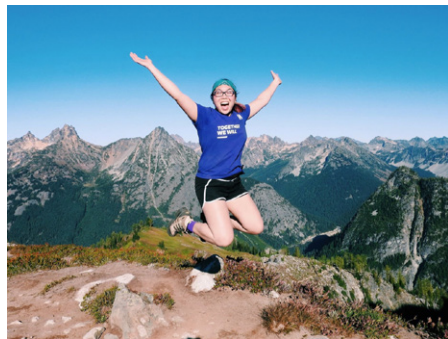
- Receive up to a \$350 stipend based on attendance and completion of program
