In My Backyard's youth program is a National Park Service summer internship program geared towards motivated high school students seeking a fun and fulfilling summer adventure in Seattle! High school students will be paired with college-aged mentors to provide personal guidance throughout the program. Students will gain valuable skills in community building, leadership, and professional development through activities, creative outlets, and hands-on experience.
